



Thank you for your interest in the EMT Program at Jersey Shore University Medical Center (JSUMC).

The next class is scheduled to begin on Saturday, January 6, 2018 at 8:30 am. The course is located at Jersey Shore University Medical Center, 1944 Route 33, Neptune, NJ. Classes will be held in Lance Auditorium, which is in the Brennan Pavilion. The entrance to the Brennan Pavilion faces Route 33.

Here are some guidelines to review before you register to the course:

Eligibility to take the course:

All applicants must have reached their 16th birthday prior to the start of the course. Anyone under the age of 18 must also provide a letter from their parents granting them permission to attend the course.

Prerequisite:

As a prerequisite, you must have completed a CPR course at the Healthcare Provider or Professional Rescuer level. The CPR certification must be valid throughout the course.

If you need CPR certification, a course will be offered on Wednesday, January 3 at 6 PM at JSUMC. To register, call the office at (732) 776-4470. There is a fee of \$60.00.

Tuition & Fees

Tuition for the course is \$1,200.00. We accept the NJ EMT Training Fund for perspective students who are a member of a volunteer EMS agency. This form must be completed, sign and turned in before or on the first day of class. Text book and online access to the learning management system are required and is not part of the tuition. The cost is \$220 and this is not covered by the training fund. You are required to provide your own stethoscope by the second week of class. If you wish, you may purchase a stethoscope through an EMS supply company, which will provide a student discount. A BP cuff is also included in the price of the stethoscope. This charge is \$30.

Refunds:

No refunds will be issued after the third scheduled class. A processing fee of \$100 will be deducted if a refund is made. Books, stethoscope, blood pressure cuffs are non-refundable.

Instructions to Register:

Obtain a NJ EMT ID number:

1. Go to njems.njlinics.net
2. Below the login, click Create a new account, only if you have not done so before.
3. You will be asked to provide a password
4. Complete the information requested
5. A six (6) digit ID will appear at the top of the page starting with the number 6
6. Log in using your ID number and password
7. Click the blue link, apply for initial certification. When the page appears, scroll to proceed. Click the link and answer the two (2) legal questions, click submit.

Register for the course (you will need the state ID number)
